Sustainable Groundwater Management Act

In 2014, California enacted the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (**SGMA**) to better manage groundwater for long-term sustainability. There are six **sustainability indicators** within **SGMA** – sustainability is achieved by avoiding significant and unreasonable conditions for these six **sustainability indicators**:

Depletion



Land Subsidence

Degradation

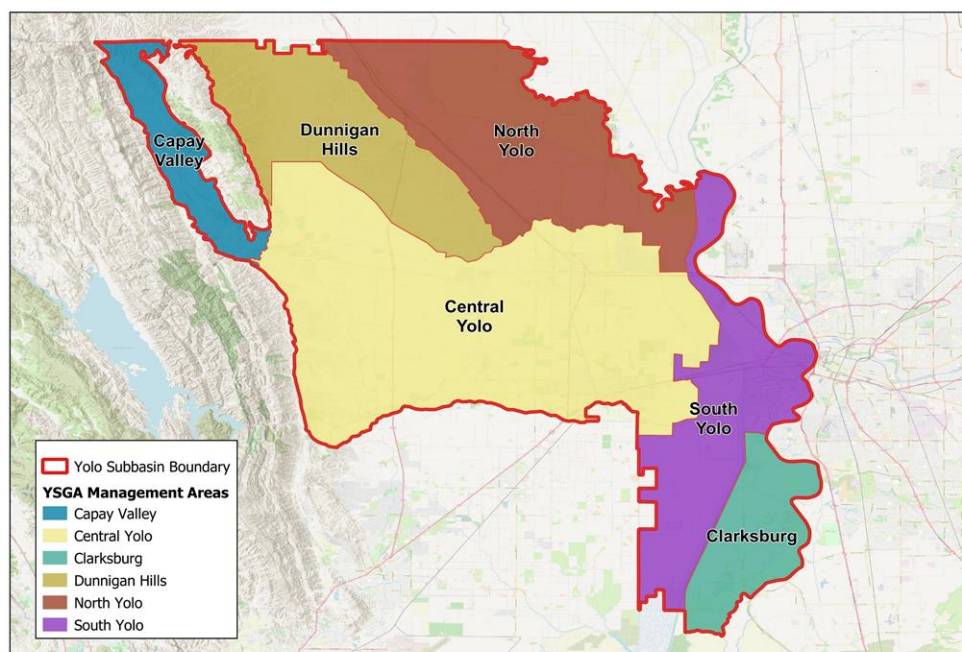


Sea Water

The Yolo Subbasin Groundwater Agency (YSGA) was formed in June 2017 to serve as the Groundwater Sustainability Agency for the Yolo Subbasin. Since 2017, the YSGA has been focused on developing a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP). The Yolo Subbasin GSP will consider all beneficial users and will define a sustainability goal for the Yolo Subbasin.

The Yolo Subbasin GSP is due to the Department of Water Resources by **January 31, 2022**.
